Old Business:

ARRL Club Membership: 50% of our membership is 33. With Andy N7SGV joining, we now have 19 ARRL members within the club.

VE Testing: Next regular testing date will be December 6. Anyone planning on upgrading?

HOLIDAY BRUNCH: Paul Carlin KE6NVU announced the December 6^{th} Brunch to be held at DeeAnn's Tea Room starting at 10 am , \$18 per person and reminded us that the Tea Room is open just for us that Saturday. He also explained the Gift Exchange (\$5 to \$10 gift or something home-made) and the limit of 2 "steals" of gifts from an individual.

Net Check-in Report from Mindy W7ZAP, net manager: Members checked in 67 times, visitors 15 times, mostly from Del Norte county.

501(c)(3) – Non-profit incorporation for PBARC was accepted at the annual meeting. The paperwork along with the \$50 check was sent in to register our Club with the state of Oregon. Paul Carlin KE6NVU mentioned that it may be a while before we hear back on that.

Great Shake Out Drill October 16th:

PBARC hams were at several venues – the 5th St. Curry Medical Center, Brookings PD, the Episcopal Church and the Presbyterian Church. From Lower Harbor or Memory Lane, a "walk to higher ground" was accomplished to destinations of the Harbor Fire Department or the Chetco Library. Paul Carlin KE6NVU commented that there were nine checkins to the Bosely Butte repeater, including Port Orford, Ophir, and Gold Beach. Also a simulated emergency message was sent to ARES in Jackson county dictated by the duty nurse at the Medical Center for transmission via Packet and Paktor3. In all, there were 8 stations making 24 reports into the 10:16 am net and 7 stations making reports into the Noon net. After the nets were secured, 8 members met for a debrief and planning session.

As a sidelight, the group walking up to the Harbor Fire station reported a vehicle fire using the FRS radio distributed for the Shakeout Drill.

Paul Carlin KE6NVU has not heard about his application to be a registered volunteer for the county.

Mindy Hamilton W7ZAP presented a thorough orientation of the new PBARC website, URL pelicanbayarc.com *Motion was made, seconded and carried, to accept the colorization of the club logo.* Doug K7KY and Mindy W7ZAP used the WORDPRESS content management system to structure the webpages. Mindy has the ability to add content with Bob and Lorraine continuing as editors. Mindy navigated through the tabs, showing us the various features designed into the website. There is an RSS feed feature available.

During the Q&A, Doren WA6MVP suggested adding ads as income source and a map of repeaters. Chris WB8YPO suggested a page for equipment sales and swaps and a link to ARRL resources.

Ron K7IOW presented the program presently being used for calling the Tuesday evening net. URL k7iow.org/nrc/netrc.cgi The program is currently running on Ron's server until development is completed. Mindy W7ZAP, net manager, can monitor the progress of a net. Ron demonstrated the ease of use in marking member and visitor check-ins as well as the report statistics. Ron encouraged members to try the program, knowing that Mindy will ignore the experimental sessions in approving the real check-in records.

Paul KE6NVU suggested having a project train emergency net control skills.
